



Year 1 – Curriculum Map : Autumn 1

Maths – We will complete the following units of work:

Children will learn to count forwards & backwards within 100, from any number. They will find out about the location of numbers to 20 & compare 1-5 using < > and =. Children will compose (from 2 parts) & partition numbers to 10 including recognising odd & even numbers.

Science

Everyday materials- Sticky Knowledge:

- Names of everyday materials.
- Materials can be described by their properties.
- All objects are made of one or more material.
- some objects can be made from different materials.
- Some materials e.g. plastic can be in different forms with very different properties.

Computing

Computing Systems and networks: Technology around us – Sticky Knowledge:

- Technology is all around us.
- Laptops and desktops are types of technology.
- Mouse, screen, keyboard, base unit (their uses).

PHONICS Children will continue to read words containing: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, oo, ow, oi, ear, air, er, s (visit) and ending in -s, -es. They will also learn to recognise & read words containing: ay (play); ou (cloud); oy (toy); ea (each).

English

Children will develop early writing skills through familiar stories including *Dogger*, *Kipper's Toy Box* and *The Three Little Pigs*. They will write for a range of purposes, including missing posters, character descriptions, narrative retells and diary entries, while building sentence construction, punctuation, use of capital letters and conjunctions. Children will also learn to sequence ideas and apply key grammar skills within their independent writing.

History
